

Minutes from the SERC meeting 10/7/13

Also another test session was scheduled at the meeting for Saturday December 14th at 9 am at the Red Cross building.

Rich Hillyer K9RWH will climb our tower at the Red Cross on Sat 10/19 at 10 am and get the rotor color code so we can get the rotor hooked up and working on our tower there.

Hans W2ZZB will have a program at our November meeting.

Bill K4FLV had some discussion with the other members about Island activation and which islands we could activate.

A motion was made and passed since we missed the deadline for nominations for club officers. That we set aside the standard procedure as outlined in the club by laws this year and have the nominations and election at the November meeting. Normally we do not have a December meeting just a Christmas party at The Dutch Heritage the night of the December meeting.

K4JP will keep track of any Sarasota County Auctions of old equipment that may come that the club might be interested in.

Motion was made and seconded that the meeting be adjourned and it passed.

We did not have a program at this meeting but we had a very enjoyable time discussing other ham radio related topics.
